Instructions:

- Cut 4-1/4' x 5-1/2" banner pieces from cardstock and punch holes in the top corners.
- Print this document and cut widely around each letter.
- Use a pencil to color in the back of each piece making sure to "cover" the letter.
- Center each letter on the appropriate banner piece (4-1/4" x 5-1/2").
- Carefully trace using a ball point pen – *this will transfer the pencil onto the banner piece. NOTE: the "j" has a flattened bottom when printed and you can simply round this when you paint if you prefer.*
- Paint in each letter.
- After the paint dries, string together your banner.
- Add ribbons or tassels between the banner pieces if you like.
