STAMPIN' UP! SUPPLY LIST

Stamp Sets: Happy Congratulations (wood 133944 | clear 133047), Remembering Your Birthday (wood 131347 | clear 131350)

Papers: Card stock in Crisp Cantaloupe (131298), Whisper White (100730)

Ink: Crisp Cantaloupe (pad 131176 | refill 131165), Coastal Cabana (pad 131175 | refill 131164), Early Espresso (pad 126974 | refill 119789)

Adhesive: Stampin' Dimensional (104045), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

Tools: 3/4" Circle Punch (119873)

TIPS + TRICKS

- Don't worry about a little overlap when you stamp the strands of lanterns – it will hardly be noticeable
- If you want the colored lantern images aligned just inside the circles, use a Stamp-a-ma-jig (I did not and some are little outside the circles but I think that adds to the handmade look of the card.

- Use the 3/4" Circle Punch and Stampin' Dimensionals to add a little depth to the card – one lantern on each strand was popped up on my card
- Jazz up the inside of the card and your envelope by stamping on a portion of the strand and adding in the colored lanterns.

Have fun creating and giving this card! There's nothing quite like a handmade gift!
